ORDINANCE 12-2011

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF REED ROAD WITHIN THE CITY OF ABSECON, COUNTY OF ATLANTIC

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Absecon, County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey:

SECTION 1: That the street described within the following boundaries is hereby vacated and all public rights therein are extinguished situate in the City of Absecon, County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey:

<u>Reed Road</u> – See Attached legal description from Schaeffer, Nassar, Scheidegg Consulting Engineers, LLC.

Containing within said bounds 5,898 Square Feet or .135 acres of Land.

Subject to covenants, restrictions and easements of record, if any, except those that may have expired by their own limitations.

SECTION 2. That every person whose land may be affected by the ordinance be notified according to law.

SECTION 3. That the public rights arising from any dedication of the City of Absecon and described above, so vacated as aforesaid, be and the same are hereby released and extinguished.

SECTION 4. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provision hereof, be and the same are hereby repealed and that this ordinance shall take effect immediately after final passage and publication.

SECTION 5. That the City Clerk shall immediately after final passage and publication of this Ordinance, make and file in the Office of the Clerk of the County of Atlantic, a copy of this Ordinance, together with a copy of the Proof of Publication, duly certified by her, under the corporate seal of the City of Absecon, for record, as required by law.
