ORDINANCE 15-2011

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE CITY OF ABSECON, CHAPTER 300 - SOLID WASTE, ARTICLE III-RECYCLING, SECTION 37 - LEAVES

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABSECON CITY, NEW JERSEY that Chapter 300, Section 37 - Leaves, be re-named and amended as follows:

Section 300-37 - Yard Waste

All person within the municipality shall separate leaves, grass, weeds, and similar growths, herein after referred to as yard waste, from other solid waste generated at their premises and unless the vard waste is stored or recycled for composting or mulch on the premises, place the vard waste at the curb or other designated area for collection at such times and dates and in the manner established by the municipality's recycling regulations. Yard waste must be placed in containers or Biodegradable leaf bags for collection. Leaves may be placed at the curb for collection by the municipality on a scheduled basis in the spring and fall of each year and need not be containerized of bagged. The schedule will be established and published each spring and fall in a general circulation newspaper and on the municipal website.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that:

- 1. Any Ordinance or parts of ordinances, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of any such inconsistency.
- 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon final adoption and publication as required by Law.
