

**ORDINANCE NO. 24-05**

**ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$150,000.00 FROM THE WATER UTILITY REVITALIZATION FUND FOR THE REDEVELOPMENT OF PUMP STATION #6 WITHIN THE CITY OF BRIDGETON, IN THE COUNTY OF CUMBERLAND, NEW JERSEY**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Bridgeton has need to undertake redevelopment of Pump Station #6 in order to ensure adequate water and sewer capacity flow to the processing plant within the City of Bridgeton; and

**WHEREAS**, Municipal Maintenance Co. is currently under contract for well and pump station repairs and has proposed options for repairs; and


**WHEREAS**, the City of Bridgeton seeks to redevelop Pump Station #6 utilizing the aforementioned method

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of the City of Bridgeton as follows:

1. \$ 150,000.00 is hereby appropriated by the City of Bridgeton from the Bridgeton Water Utility Revitalization Fund for the redevelopment of Pump Station #6, including labor, materials, and any incidental costs
2. The City of Bridgeton hereby certifies that it has adopted a temporary capital budget to be filed with the Division of Local Government Services.
3. This ordinance shall take effect after adoption and final publication


