

**ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF DEPTFORD AMENDING BOND ORDINANCE
O.9.18 OF THE TOWNSHIP OF DEPTFORD, IN THE COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER,
NEW JERSEY**

WHEREAS, on May 21, 2018, the Township of Deptford, County of Gloucester, New Jersey ("Township") duly and finally adopted Bond Ordinance O.9.18 ("Bond Ordinance"), authorizing various general capital improvements in and for the Township ("Prior Improvements"); and

WHEREAS, the Township desires to amend the appropriations authorized in the Bond Ordinance by amending Section 7 thereof.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Council of the Township (not less than two-thirds of all the members thereof affirmatively concurring), pursuant to the provisions of the Local Bond Law, Chapter 169 of the Laws of 1960 of the State of New Jersey, as amended and supplemented ("Local Bond Law"), as follows:

Section 1. Section 7 and 8 of the Bond Ordinance are hereby amended and restated in their entirety to provide as follows:

"Section 7. The improvements hereby authorized and the purposes for which said obligations are to be issued; the estimated costs of each said purpose; the amount of down payment for each said purpose; the maximum amount of obligations to be issued for each said purpose and the period of usefulness of each said purpose within the limitations of the Local Bond Law are as follows:

C. Replacement of the Public Works Gas System, together with the acquisition of all materials and equipment and completion of all work necessary therefor or related thereto	350,000	17,500	332,500	15 years

Acquisition of Various Heavy Replacement Equipment for the Public Works Department including, but not limited to, Street Sweepers and Front-End Loaders, together with the acquisition of all materials and equipment and completion of all work necessary therefor or related thereto	403,000	20,150	382,850	15 years
F. Acquisition of Various Equipment for the Public Works Department including, but not limited to, Tractors and All-Wheel Drive Vehicles, together with the acquisition of all materials and equipment and completion of all work necessary therefor or related thereto	374,000	18,700	355,300	5 years
G. Various Improvements to Township Buildings and Grounds including, but not limited to, Court Room, Police Locker Rooms, Security Systems and HVAC Controls, together with the acquisition of all materials and equipment and completion of all work necessary therefor or related thereto	686,000	34,300	651,700	15 years

Section 2. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith and the regulations promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail the amended applicable capital budget and applicable capital improvement program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services, New Jersey Department of Community Affairs, are on file with the Clerk and available for public inspection.

Section 3. All other parts of the Bond Ordinance not amended hereby shall remain in full force and effect.

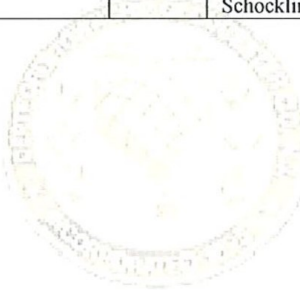
Section 4. In accordance with the Local Bond Law, this ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after the first publication thereof after final passage.
