

**ORDINANCE AMENDING BOND ORDINANCE 15-2012 OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
DEPTFORD, COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER, NEW JERSEY**

BACKGROUND

WHEREAS, the Township of Deptford, County of Gloucester, New Jersey ("Township") has heretofore duly and finally adopted Bond Ordinance 15-2012 authorizing the acquisition of various pieces of equipment and the completion of various capital improvements in and for the Township ("Bond Ordinance"); and

WHEREAS, the Township is desirous of amending Section 7(d) of the Bond Ordinance to expand the purposes set forth therein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL (NOT LESS THAN TWO-THIRDS OF ALL THE MEMBERS THEREOF AFFIRMATIVELY CONCURRING), PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE LOCAL BOND LAW, CHAPTER 169 OF THE LAWS OF 1960 OF THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AS AMENDED AND SUPPLEMENTED ("LOCAL BOND LAW"), AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 7(D). of the Bond Ordinance is hereby amended to provide as follows:

"Section 7. The improvements hereby authorized and the purposes for which said obligations are to be issued; the estimated costs of each said purpose; the amount of down payment for each said purpose; the maximum amount obligations to be issued for each said purpose and the period of usefulness of each said purpose within the limitations of the Local Bond Law are as follows:

<u>Purpose/Improvement</u>	<u>Estimated Total Cost</u>	<u>Down Payment</u>	<u>Amount of Obligations</u>	<u>Period of Usefulness</u>
A. Construction of Veterans Park Memorial; together with the acquisition of all materials and equipment and completion of all work necessary therefor or related thereto, all as more particularly described in the plans and specifications on file in the office of the Township Clerk	\$35,000	\$2,000	\$33,000	15 years

Section 2. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith and the regulations promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail the amended capital budget and capital improvement program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services, New Jersey Department of Community Affairs, are on file with the Township Clerk and available for public inspection.

Section 3. All other parts of the Bond Ordinance not amended hereby shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. In accordance with the Local Bond Law, this ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after the first publication thereof after final passage.


