ORDINANCE NO. 2021-05

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF DERRY, DAUPHIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF DERRY AT CHAPTER 210, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, SECTION 210-12, MAXIMUM SPEED LIMITS ESTABLISHED ON CERTAIN STREETS, BY ESTABLISHING A SPEED LIMIT OF 25 MILES PER HOUR FOR MOTOR VEHICLES ON CERTAIN PORTIONS OF CERTAIN STREETS WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP.

Preamble

The Derry Township Board of Supervisors, upon the recommendation of the Township Engineer, Police Chief and/or Roadmaster, and pursuant to the appropriate engineering and/or traffic studies where necessary, hereby enacts and ordains as follows:

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Derry, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

ARTICLE I.

Words and phrases used in this Ordinance shall have the meaning ascribed to them in the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code, 1976, June 17, P.L. 162, Act No. 81, as amended.

ARTICLE II.

Chapter 210, Section 210-12, Maximum Speed Limits Established on Certain Streets, of the Derry Township Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by the addition of the following maximum speed limits for the following portions of streets within the Township:

ARTICLE III.

The proper authorities of the Township are directed to erect official signs establishing the speeds at the above-referenced locations at twenty-five (25) miles per hour, and to do so in conformity with the provisions of the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code and this Ordinance.

ARTICLE IV.

Repealer. All ordinances, parts of ordinances, resolutions and/or amendments thereof, inconsistent herewith in the Township of Derry, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania are hereby repealed.

ARTICLE V.

Severability. If any section, paragraph, sub-section, clause, or provision of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof other than that portion specifically declared invalid.

ARTICLE VI.

Savings Clause. Nothing in this Ordinance hereby adopted shall be construed to affect any suit or proceedings pending in court, or any rights acquired, or liability incurred, or any causes of action accrued or existing under an Ordinance hereby repealed as cited in Article IV of this Ordinance: nor shall any just or legal right or remedy or any character be lost, impaired, or affected by this Ordinance.

ARTICLE VII.

Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective as soon as permitted by law after enactment.
