



ORDINANCE 05-2024**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 225 PARKS OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF ELDON, MISSOURI, BY REVISING SECTION 225.090 ELDON AQUATIC PARK - FEE SCHEDULE.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF ELDON, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:


- Section 1. That Chapter 225.090 Eldon Aquatic Park - Fee Schedule, of the Municipal Code of the City of Eldon, Missouri is hereby revised. Deletions have a "strike through" (~~example~~) and additions are in **bold**.
- Section 2. Chapter 225 Parks shall be substantially the same in form and content as attached hereto as Exhibit A.
- Section 3 This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

Chapter 225. Parks

Article II. Eldon Aquatic Park

Section 225.090. Eldon Aquatic Park — Fee Schedule.

The Eldon Aquatic Fee Schedule shall be substantially the same in form and content as set forth below:

ELDON AQUATIC PARK Fee Schedule

Family Pass — \$175.00

Limit of five (5) persons per pass including husband and/or wife and immediate children who are 18 years and under for which you are financially responsible, and everyone is living at the same address plus an additional \$30.00 per person for any additional entries over the initial five (5) persons for which you are financially responsible and living at the same address.

Lost or stolen pool passes cannot be replaced.

Individual Pass — \$75.00

May only be purchased at City Hall

Unlimited entries for one (1) individual named at the time of purchase.

Half-Day Pass — \$50.00

This pass allows one (1) person to enter the pool between the hours of 3:00 P.M. and 6:00 P.M. every day of the week that the pool is open.

Daily Admission

Adults and children	\$4.00
Children 3 and under admitted	\$2.00
Adults 65 years and older admitted	\$2.00
Military Discount with ID	\$2.00

Daily Admission with unlimited entries

Adults and children	\$8.00
Adults 65 years and older admitted	\$4.00
Children 3 and under admitted	\$4.00
Military Discount with ID	\$4.00

The following special activities will be offered at half-price admission:
Morning Splash, Family Night, and Lap Swim.

Anyone entering the pool without swim attire must remain in the concession area.

Private Swim Party

For 25- 50 people or less	\$125.00 \$150.00
For 26 to 50 51 to 100 people	\$150.00 \$200.00
For 51 to 75 more than 101 to occupancy people	\$175.00 \$250.00
For more than 75 people	\$200.00

All pool parties must be scheduled with the Parks and Recreation Department at the Eldon Community Center. All fees must be paid at the time of the booking date. Once an applicant makes a reservation, all fees must be paid at the Community Center or the Pool. A minimum of three (3) business days' notice is required to make a reservation. Refunds for bad weather only. Each private swim party will be two (2) hours in length.

All pool parties must be scheduled with the Parks and Recreation Department **or City Hall.** ~~at the Eldon Community Center.~~ All fees must be paid **at City Hall within 10 days** ~~the time of the~~ **booking date.** ~~Once an applicant makes a reservation, all fees must be paid at the Community Center or the Pool.~~ A minimum of three (3) business days' notice is required to make a reservation. Refunds for bad weather only. Each private swim party will be two (2) hours in length.

POOL HOURS

Monday — Saturday: 12:00 P.M. — 6:00 P.M.
Sunday: 1:00 P.M. — 6:00 P.M.

The pool will be closed during inclement weather or when there are not an adequate number of swimmers in attendance. It will also be closed to the public when hosting swim meets.
