AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EVESHAM
AMENDING CHAPTER 26 OF THE CODE OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF EVESHAM ENTITLED "POLICE DEPARTMENT"

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Evesham, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey that Chapter 26 of the Code of the Township of Evesham is amended as follows:

<u>SECTION I.</u> The following sections are amended and revised with the following language:

§ 26-7 **Promotions.** (E)(3)Record review.

(b)

The reviewing committee shall examine the length and merit of candidate's service. The examination process shall give specific weight to, experience, military service, demonstrated leadership ability, education and disciplinary history.

<u>SECTION II.</u> The following section is removed in its entirety: $\S 26-7$ **Promotions.** (E)(3)Record review (c)(1) Sergeant

SECTION III. The following section § 26-7 Promotions. (E)(3)Record review (c)(2) Lieutenant, Captain, Deputy Chief is amended and revised with the following language:
