ORDINANCE NO. 22-10-2023

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EVESHAM  
AMENDING CHAPTER 26 OF THE CODE OF THE  
TOWNSHIP OF EVESHAM ENTITLED "POLICE DEPARTMENT"

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Evesham, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey that Chapter 26 of the Code of the Township of Evesham is amended as follows:

SECTION I. The following sections are amended and revised with the following language:

**§ 26-7 Promotions. (E)(3)Record review.**

**(b)**

The reviewing committee shall examine the length and merit of candidate's service. The examination process shall give specific weight to, experience, military service, demonstrated leadership ability, education and disciplinary history.

SECTION II. The following section is removed in its entirety:

**§ 26-7 Promotions. (E)(3)Record review (c)(1) Sergeant**

SECTION III. The following section **§ 26-7 Promotions. (E)(3)Record review (c)(2) Lieutenant, Captain, Deputy Chief** is amended and revised with the following language:

**[1] Sergeant, Lieutenant, Captain, Deputy Chief.**

	If Associates Degree or 60 college credits and two years of active-duty military experience (including Coast Guard) or six years' Reserves or National Guard will be worth 5%, if honorably discharged	
	Discipline shall be a minus depending on seriousness and freshness of record	

SECTION II. INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES:

All Ordinances and provisions thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION III. DECLARATION OF INVALIDITY:

If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision and the remainder of this ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

SECTION IV. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall take effect upon final adoption and publication in accordance with the law.
