TOWNSHIP OF JACKSON ORDINANCE NO. 24-02

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF JACKSON, BUTLER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 15, MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC PART 2, TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, SECTION 15-201, MAXIMUM SPEED LIMITS ESTABLISHED, BY DECREASING THE SPEED LIMITS NEAR SENECA TRAILS AND SECTION 15-204, STOP INTERSECTIONS ESTABLISHED, IN ORDER TO ADD STOP SIGNS TO DESIGNATED ROADS WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, Chapter 15, Part 2 of the Jackson Township Code of Ordinances, Traffic Regulations, authorizes the Township of Jackson (the "Township") to regulate stop intersections in the Township, and

WHEREAS, the Township Board of Supervisors desires to amend the Motor Vehicles and Traffic Ordinance in order to establish additional stop intersections and maximum speed limits in order to maintain, preserve, and protect the public safety and welfare, and

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Jackson hereby ordains and enacts as follows, incorporating the above recital by reference:

Section 1. Chapter 15 of the Jackson Township Code of Ordinances, Motor Vehicles and Traffic, Part 2, Traffic Regulations, Section 15-201, Maximum Speed Limits Established, is amended as follows to insert the underlined text and remove the stricken text:

Street	Maximum Speed Limit (mph)	
Gudekunst Road	<u>25</u> 35	

Section 2. Chapter 15 of the Jackson Township Code of Ordinances, Motor Vehicles and Traffic, Part 2, Traffic Regulations, Section 15-204, Stop Intersections Established, shall be amended by removing the strike-through text and adding the underlined text:

Street	Stop Intersection	Direction of Travel
Shaleigh Drive	Sarjean Way	East
Shaleigh Drive	Sarjean Way	West
Sarjean Way	Shaleigh Drive	North

Section 3. All prior ordinances are hereby repealed in whole or in part to the extent inconsistent herewith.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect in accordance with applicable law.
