ORDINANCE 23-13

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE CAESAR RODNEY LIBRARY TAX DISTRICT

THE COUNTY OF KENT HEREBY ORDAINS:

- Pursuant to the provisions of 9 <u>Del. C.</u> § 801 et. seq. there is hereby established a Caesar Rodney Library Tax District, a legal description for which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and a map illustrating same is attached hereto as Exhibit "B" and made a part hereof.
- There is hereby created a Library Commission for the purpose of advising the Levy Court on the operation of the Library District and the Officers, Members and Rules and Regulations for the Commission shall be designated and from time to time amended by resolution of the Levy Court of Kent County.
- 3. The County shall levy and raise by taxation a special Caesar Rodney Library Tax for the purpose of the establishment of said Library District, and for the maintenance and increase and support of Library such sum of money as is annually approved in a budget for such purpose by the Levy Court with said budget to be adopted at the same time the annual County budget is adopted. Said Library Tax shall be levied upon the real property located within the Caesar Rodney Library District according to most recent assessment list in the County and shall be in addition to and levied at the same time as the County Tax.
- 4. If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid for any reason whatsoever, same shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance which shall continue in full force and effect; and to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

- 2. Thence following said ditch west to parcel SM-00-113.00-02-34.00-000
- 3. Following the southern line of said parcel to Bay Road (State Route 1)
- 4. Thence with Bay Road (ST RT 1) south to the old part of Mulberrie Point Road that ran between Bay Road (ST RT 1) and Clapham Road
- 5. Following said old road west to Clapham Road
- 6. Thence north on Clapham Road to Buffalo Road
- 7. Thence southwest with said road to parcel Sm-00-122.00-01-02.01-000
- 8. With said parcel north till it meets SM-00-122.00-01-02.00-000
- 9. Thence southwesterly with said parcel until it meets SM-00-121.00-01-77.00-000
- 10. Thence along the northern property line of said parcel till it comes to Cedarfield Road. This segment of Cedarfied Road is a private road / easement between parcel along said road
- 11. Following said road / easement to parcel SM-00-121.00-01-61.00-000
- 12. Thence following said parcel south then west to SM-00-121.00-01-57.02-000
- 13. Thence following said parcel west then south to parcel SM-00-121.00-01-56.07-000
- 14. Then along the north property line of said parcel and parcel SM-00-121.00-01-25.01-000 to McGinnis Pond Road
- 15. Thence west with said road to Hudson Branch
- 16. Thence west with said branch to Fox Chase Road
- 17.North on Fox Chase road crossing Barratts Chapel Road and past Kings Mill Drive to the division line of parcel SM-00-121.00-01-02.02-000 and Pinehust Village
- 18. Thence following northeatern boundary of Pinehurst Village till it meets Irish Hill Road
- 19. Thence along said road west to parcel SM-00-121.00-01-01.00-000
- 20. Thence along the dividing line of said parcel and Pinehurst Village back to Irish Hill Road
- 21. Thence along said road west to parcel NM-00-120.00-01-61.01-000
- 22. Thence north along said parcel until it meets parcel NM-00-111.04-06-05.00-000
- 23. Thence along said parcel west then north till it meets Double Run

- 24. Then west with said run to Barney Jenkins Road
- 25. Thence with Barney Jenkins Road south then west crossing S DuPont Hwy (ST RT 13) till it ends at Upper King Road
- 26. Thence with Upper King Road north to Olin Dill Road
- 27. Thence south and west with said road crossing Turkey Point Road till it ends at Farm Lane
- 28. Thence north with Farm Lane till Henry Cowgill Rd (ST Rt 10A)
- 29. Thence west with said road (ST RT 10A) to Berrytown Road
- 30. Thence with said Berrytown Road south to the division between parcels NM-00-118.00-01-47.00-000 and NM-00-119.00-01-34.00-000
- 31. Thence with said division line and continuing along parcel NM-00-118.00-01-47.00-000 to Fire Tower Road
- 32. Then west along Fire Tower Road to C and R Center Road
- 33. Thence southwesterly along C and R Center Road to Ironmine Road
- 34. Thence north with Ironmine Road to Horsepend Road
- 35. Thence west with Horsepend Road to where it crosses Horspend Ditch
- 36. Thence northwesterly with said ditch crossing Cabin Ridge Road to a point where it meets Meredith Branch
- 37. Thence from said point along the dividing line of parcels SM-00-117.00-01-11.00-000 and Sm-00-126.00-01-09.00-000 westerly to a point on the division between parcels SM-00-126.00-01-06.00-000 and SM-00-126.00-01-07.00-000
- 38. Thence with the division line between said properties thence joining and running with, and continuing with, Meredith Branch south to Sandtown Road
- 39. Thence westerly with Sandtown Road and crossing Mt Olive Cemetery Road and continuing with Sandtown Road till it ends at Willow Grove Road
- 40. Thence west with Willow Grove Road to the state of Maryland line
