LEGAL NOTICE NOTICE OF ADOPTION AMENDMENT TO VEHICLE & TRAFFIC ORDINANCE TOWN OF LANCASTER, COUNTY OF ERIE, STATE OF NEW YORK

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Vehicle and Traffic Ordinance of the Town of Lancaster, Erie County, New York, designated as Chapter 350 of the Code of the Town of Lancaster is hereby amended as follows:

ARTICLE X Parking, Standing and Stopping

- § 350-15. Parking prohibited in designated locations.
- A. The parking of vehicles is hereby prohibited in any of the following locations:
 - (15) Countryside Subdivision. [Added 11-19-1979; amended 10-17-1983]
 - (k) On the east and west sides of Sara Lane from the intersection with Country Place for a distance of two hundred fifty (250') feet.
 - (27) On the north side of Maple Drive from its intersection with Transit Road to a point 1,950 feet east of said intersection. [Added 9-2-1986]
 - (a) On the east side of Maple Drive for a distance of two hundred fifty (250') feet south of the traffic-controlled turn which begins approximately 1,950 feet east of the intersection of Maple Drive and Transit Road, beginning November 1 of each year and ending March 31 of each year.
- § 350-16. Standing prohibited in designated locations.
- A. The standing of vehicles is hereby prohibited in any of the following locations:
 - (15) Countryside Subdivision. [Added 11-19-1979; amended 10-17-1983]
 - (k) On the east and west sides of Sara Lane from the intersection with Country Place for a distance of two hundred fifty (250') feet.
 - (27) On the north side of Maple Drive from its intersection with Transit Road to a point 1,950 feet east of said intersection. [Added 9-2-1986]
 - (a) On the east side of Maple Drive for a distance of two hundred fifty (250') feet south of the traffic-controlled turn which begins approximately 1,950 feet east of the intersection of Maple Drive and Transit Road, beginning November 1 of each year and ending March 31 of each year.
