

ORDINANCE NO. 2023-2

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 327, ARTICLE I, STREET OPENING AND CURB CUTS, SECTION 327-12(D) OF THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF LATROBE, COUNTY OF WESTMORELAND, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA**

NOW, THEREFORE, be it enacted and ordained by the Council of the City of Latrobe, and the City of Latrobe hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 327-12(D) shall be amended as follows:

If paving surfaces adjacent to the street openings may be damaged where trenches are made parallel to the street, where trenches and/or street openings are laid through and/or along the right of way, where cross trenches are laid in proximity to one another, or where the equipment used may cause such damage to the roadway, the municipality shall, if the total linear length of the street opening and/or trench repair, parallel or perpendicular to the direction of travel, exceeds 250 linear feet or ~~exceeds is~~ **25% or more** of the length of the road, ~~whichever is less, require a full-width, or lane width as appropriate~~ **the entire street shall be milled and paved curb to curb and street to street at a minimum of 1.5" mill and 1.5" pavement meeting all specifications established by the City of Latrobe's Department of Public Works.** ~~overlay of the affected area.~~ The municipality may require a contribution from the permittee for the resurfacing of the entire roadway in lieu of patching or restoration. Such negotiations shall be carried on and contributions agreed upon prior to issuance of a permit. (Amendment appears in BOLDFACE/STRIKE THROUGH).


SECTION 2. That all other provisions of Chapter 327 not repealed or amended herein shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. That the within Ordinance shall take effect on the date of publication of the post-enactment notice of passage of the same,

SECTION 4. That the City Manager, the City Secretary, and any other proper City officer is authorized and directed to execute any and all documents and to take any and all action necessary in order to carry in effect the within ordinance.
