

ORDINANCE NO. 24- 2023

ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LIVINGSTON AMENDING § 274-13., INSTALLATION OF SIDEWALKS, OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE TO ADD A NEW § 274-13.F. AUTHORIZING LIMITED EXEMPTIONS

WHEREAS, § 274-13 of the Township Code regulates the installation of sidewalks in the Township, including setting forth locations where sidewalks are required; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council has determined that it is appropriate to provide for an exemption from such requirements under certain limited circumstances.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Council of the Township of Livingston, in the County of Essex, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. § 274-13, Installation of Sidewalks, of the Township Code is hereby amended to add the following new § 274-13.F.:

F. An exemption from the required installation of sidewalks under § 274-13 B. (3) and (4), C. (3) and (4), and D. (3) and (4) above may be granted as provided hereafter:


(1) An exemption from the sidewalk installation requirement for a property may be granted if all of the following conditions exist:

- a. The property is located on a dead end road and within two hundred (200) feet of the dead end of the improved roadway, and
- b. There are no cross streets between the property and the terminus of the dead end of the improved roadway, and
- c. The terminus of the dead end of the improved roadway does not adjoin any improved walkway or entrance to any park, school or public facility, and
- d. There are no sidewalks installed between the property and the dead end of the improved roadway.


(2) Any exemption granted under this section shall terminate, and there shall be no grandfathering of such exemption, if the dead end roadway is subsequently opened and improved, or if an improved walkway or entrance is subsequently installed to any park, school or public facility which is adjacent to the terminus of the dead end of the improved roadway.

Section 2. Except as hereby amended, the Code of the Township of Livingston shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect in accordance with law.
