

**ORDINANCE NO. 2024- 06**

**APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND RECONCILING THE CITY OF LINCOLN  
BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LINCOLN,  
ARKANSAS:

Section One: Title. This ordinance shall be known as An Ordinance Amending and Reconciling the City of Lincoln Budget for Fiscal Year 2023, and for Other Purposes.


Section Two: Findings: The City Council of the City of Lincoln, Arkansas adopted a budget for fiscal year 2023 by passage of Ordinance 2022-41. The revenues and expenditures during the year varied somewhat from budgeted figures. The City's auditors review the extent by which actual revenues and expenditures vary from budgeted figures. Therefore, the attached schedule of amended and reconciled revenues and expenditures should be adopted as the budget governing City operations from January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2023.

Section Three: Reconciliation and Amendment of Budget. The City Council hereby amends and reconciles its budget of fiscal year 2023, adopted by Ordinance 2022-41, with the attached amended and reconciled budget being the budget governing city operations from January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2023. This amended and reconciled budget is incorporated into the body of this Ordinance as if it had been set out word-for-word and number-for-number in the body of the Ordinance.

Section Four: Votes Required, Readings, Effective Date. This is an Appropriation Ordinance. In accordance with A.C.A. § 14-55-204 and A.C.A. § 14-55-203(c)(2), this ordinance is not an ordinance of a general or permanent nature. As such, it requires only a simple majority of votes of the City Council to pass and does not require three separate readings. This ordinance is effective immediately upon its passage.
