#### **ORDINANCE 2023-2**

AN ORDINANCE ADDING A SPECIAL PURPOSE PARKING ZONE TO SCHEDULE II-D WHICH IS CONTAINED IN THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MANHEIM AT § 480-75
AND IS REFERRED TO IN § 480-24, PROVIDING ADDITION TO SCHEDULE I-H OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE FOR ERECTING STOP SIGN

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Manheim, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 480-75, Schedule II-D of the Code of the Township of Manheim, as amended ("Code"), is hereby amended to establish the following parking special purpose parking zone, the same shall be added to those set forth in Schedule II-D of the Code, the appropriate signs shall be posted as set forth in the applicable Engineering and Traffic Studies attached to and made a part of this Ordinance:

Schedule I-H of the Code of the Township of Manheim, as amended ("Code"), which is contained at § 480-66 and referred to at § 480-15, is hereby amended to establish the following stop intersections, the same shall be added to those set forth in Schedule I-H of the Code, and the appropriate sign shall be posted as set forth in the applicable Engineering and Traffic Study.

SECTION 3. Should any paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the remainder of said Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect, and the same shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall become effective upon enactment.






Criteria exists to post a 20' Reserved Parking zone (Handicapped) In front of 631 Janet Ave.




