

TOWNSHIP OF NORTH FAYETTE RESOLUTION NO. 31-24

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH FAYETTE, COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE PAYMENT OF INVOICES RELATED TO EXPENSES ASSOCIATED WITH THE SUMMIT PARK DRIVE BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Township of North Fayette (hereinafter "Township"), is a Municipal Corporation, duly organized and existing under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, the Summit Park Drive Bridge (hereinafter "Structure") is owned by the Township and is in need of replacement; and

WHEREAS, the Township has retained the services of Mackin Engineering Company (hereinafter "Mackin") to provide design and engineering services related to the replacement structure; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to an agreement with the County of Allegheny (hereinafter "County"), the County is financially responsible for all costs associated with the replacement of the structure; and

WHEREAS, the County has partnered with the Southwestern Pennsylvania Commission (hereinafter "SPC") and the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (hereinafter "PennDOT") to provide funding to the Township for design and engineering expenses related to the replacement structure; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 14-23, the Township has entered into a reimbursement agreement with PennDOT to receive funding; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the reimbursement agreement, the Township will pay invoices submitted by Mackin after receiving payment for the invoices by PennDOT.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of North Fayette hereby resolves as follows, incorporating the above recitals by reference:

The Township Manager and Director of Budget & Finance are hereby authorized and directed to remit payment to Mackin for costs associated with the Summit Park Drive Bridge Replacement Project in accordance with the reimbursement agreement.

Payments to Mackin will only be made after deposit of the reimbursement funding from PennDOT into the Township's bank account(s).

SECTION 3. All prior resolutions are hereby repealed in whole or in part to the extent inconsistent herewith.

SECTION 4. <u>This Resolution shall take effect immediately.</u>

AND NOW, this 26th day of March 2024, upon motion duly made and seconded, the foregoing **RESOLUTION** is hereby adopted.
