§ 143-4. Organizations exempt from fee.

Any religious, educational, fraternal, charitable, civic, military or beneficial organization of the Village giving any form of entertainment may obtain a license free of charge.

§ 143-5. Fees.

The license fees are hereby fixed as follows:

- A. For the exhibition or parade of a circus, menagerie or caraven: \$50 per day.
- B. For the performance or exhibition of a merry-go-round or carousel: \$10 per day.
- C. For the maintenance of a dance hall or skating rink, or a combination of both in the same building and by the same party, for one year or any part thereof: \$100.
- D. For the conducting or maintenance of bowling alleys, a billiard or pocket billiard room, shows, concerts, theatricals, moving pictures or other similar exhibitions or performances: \$30 for one year or any part thereof.
- E. Hand organ or mechanical organ: \$1 per day.
- § 143-6. Penalties for offenses.

Any person violating the provisions of this chapter or any part thereof shall be liable for and pay a penalty not exceeding \$10,000.00 for each offense, and in addition thereto, such violation shall constitute and is hereby declared to be disorderly conduct, and any person violating the same shall be and is hereby declared to be a disorderly person.
