#### **ORDINANCE NUMBER 2724-23**

# AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 523 "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC" TO UPDATE AND REVISE VARIOUS PROVISIONS AND SECTIONS

**WHEREAS,** the Borough Council of the Borough of Roselle previously adopted Ordinance 1665 on April 8, 1987, which repealed and replaced the Borough's traffic ordinances; and

**WHEREAS,** the Borough Council has recently worked with the Roselle Police Department on multiple amendments to Chapter 523 of the Borough Code and has noticed various inconsistencies and outdated provisions that require comprehensive updates; and

**WHEREAS,** the Borough Council finds it is in the best interest of the residents of the Borough of Roselle to make said amendments to comprehensively update the Borough's traffic regulations.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Roselle that:

#### **SECTION I.** Amendments to Article I General Provisions

Chapter 523 "Vehicles and Traffic," Article I "General Provisions" of the Code of the Borough of Roselle is hereby amended as follows (additions in **bold**, deletions struck through):

#### §523-4 Violations and penalties.

Unless another penalty is expressly provided by New Jersey statute, or except as specifically provided in some other section of this chapter, every person convicted of a violation of a provision of this chapter or any supplement thereto shall be liable to a penalty of not more than \$\frac{100250}{100250}\$ or imprisonment for a term not exceeding 15 days, or both.

#### **SECTION II. Amendments to Article II Traffic Regulations**

Chapter 523 "Vehicles and Traffic," Article II "Traffic Regulations" of the Code of the Borough of Roselle is hereby amended as follows (additions in **bold**, deletions struck through):

#### §523-12 Stop intersections and multi-way stop intersections.

B. The intersections described in Schedule VIIIB (§ 523-118B), attached to and made part of this chapter, are hereby designated as multi-way stop intersections. Stop signs shall be installed as provided therein.

#### §523-13 Yield intersections.

The intersections described in Schedule IX (§523-119), attached to and made a part of this chapter, are hereby designated as yield intersections. Yield signs shall be installed as provided therein.

#### §523-14 Lane use reservations.

The lane locations described in Schedule X (§523-120), attached to and made a part of this chapter, are hereby designated as lane use reservations and traffic shall move only as indicated.

B. Vehicles over three tons! gross weight are prohibited on West Fifth Avenue between Robins Street and Cristiani Street.

#### §523-17 Mid-block crosswalks.

The locations described in Schedule XXVIII (§523-137), attached to and made a part of this chapter, are hereby designated as mid-block crosswalks. It shall be lawful for pedestrians to cross at designated mid-block crosswalks.

#### SECTION III. Amendments to Article III Parking, Standing and Stopping

Chapter 523 "Vehicles and Traffic," Article III "Parking, Standing and Stopping" of the Code of the Borough of Roselle is hereby amended as follows (additions in **bold**, deletions struck through):

#### §523-20 **Permit Pparking permit on areas in public lots.**

The locations described in Schedule XXVI (§523-135), attached to and made a part of this chapter, are hereby designated as permit parking areas.

#### §523-21 Application of regulations.

The provisions of this article shall be applicable to all permit parking areas in municipal parking lots **described in Schedule XXVI** (§523-135)located at 217 Chestnut Street, Block 3101, Lot 33.01, and 130 East Second Avenue, Block 3101, Lot 5. These regulations shall be deemed to be in addition to any special regulations provided for in any individual parking lot.

- §523-22 Permit parking regulations.
  - B. Permit parking is established in the following municipal lots described in Schedule XXVI (§523-135): 217 Chestnut Street, Block 3101, Lot 33.01, and 130 East Second Avenue, Block 3101, Lot 5, as indicated in this article.
  - C. The fee for obtaining one parking permit shall be as described in Schedule XXVI (§523-135)\$60 per quarter, payable in advance.

#### §523-23 Preferential parking zones.

No vehicle shall be parked or stopped adjacent to any space in a preferential parking zone described in Schedule XXVII (§523-136), attached to and made a part of this chapter.

- §523-29 Parking restrictions and prohibitions for trucks, buses, and commercial vehicles.
  - A. Wherever any words or phrases are used in this section, the meaning respectfully ascribed to them in Title 39:1-1, Definitions, of the New Jersey Statutes Annotated shall be deemed to apply to such wards and phrases used herein.
  - AB. No person shall park any vehicles other than passenger automobiles truck, bus, truck/trailer, truck semitrailer, jitney, pickup trucks, vans or trucks of any type with commercial markings, trucks of any type loaded or equipped in a manner that would lead a reasonable observer to believe that same was being used for commercial or industrial purposes, or recreational vehicles, upon any street within the Borough of Roselle between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. Vehicles specifically prohibited under this section shall include, but not be limited to, the following:
    - (1) Trucks over four (4) tons gross weight;
    - (2) Buses of any type;
    - (3) Truck tractors:
    - (4) Trailers:
    - (5) Semitrailers:
    - (6) Recreation vehicles:
    - (7) Boats or other watercraft;
    - (8) Vehicles of any type with commercial license plates or markings; and
    - (9) Vehicles of any type loaded or equipped in a manner that would lead a reasonable observer to believe that same was being used for commercial purposes.
  - BC. Exceptions. Pickup or delivery and services.
    - (1) Vehicles other than passenger automobiles may park on streets within the Borough of Roselle betweenNotwithstanding the foregoing, hereafter, there shall be no parking on any street within the Borough of Roselle of the following vehicles, at any time, except during the hours of 6:00 a.m. andto-7:00 p.m. for the pickup and delivery of material; on or in front at such building in which the vehicle shall be parked in front of (while actively loading and unloading;), or while the owner/driver is providing a service or commodity to a residence, business, or commercial facility when such vehicles are being used for work in connection with the furnishing or supplying of the service or commodity.:
      - (a) Trucks with a registered gross vehicle weight of 4 (tons) or both;
      - (b) Buses of any type;
      - (c) Truck/trailer;

- (d) Truck semitrailer;
- (e) Jitneys;
- (f) Pickup trucks, vans or trucks of any type with commercial markings;
- (g) Trucks of any type loaded or equipped in a manner that would lead a reasonable observer to believe that same was being used for commercial or industrial purposes; and
- (h) Recreational vehicles, at any time, except for the pickup and delivery of material on or in front at such building in which the vehicle shall be parked in front of:
- (2) For purpose of this section, "recreational vehicles" will be defined as self-propelled or towed vehicle equipped to serve as temporary living quarters for recreational, camping or traveling purposes. Additionally, boats on trailers used solely for family or personal purposes will be considered recreational vehicles.
- (2) The provisions of this section shall not apply to authorized emergency vehicles.
- D. (3) The provisions of this section shall not apply to vehicles owned by a public utility as defined in N.J.S.A. 48:2-13 when such vehicles are being used for work in connection with the furnishing or supplying of the commodity which by law the public utility is authorized to furnish or supply.
- CE. Proper signs shall be erected by the Police Department pursuant to law (N.J.S.A. 39:4-198).
- **DF**. Violations and penalties.
  - (1) Any person, association or corporation who shall violate the provisions of this section shall, upon conviction, be subject to a fine of not less than \$250 nor more than \$2,000 or imprisonment for a period not to exceed 30 days, or both, at the discretion of the court.
  - (2) In addition to the above penalties set forth in Subsection **D**F(1), the Borough Police Department, after the issuance of a second summons to the same vehicle within a thirty-day period, may cause such vehicle to be towed or otherwise removed from the public street or municipal property with the owner of such vehicle being responsible for the cost of such removal.

#### §523-34 No aAngle parking in Borough.

No person shall park a vehicle upon any of the streets or parts thereof described in Schedule XIX (§523-128), **attached to and made a part of this chapter**, except at the angle designated and only within the painted stall lines. On all streets and portions thereof where angle parking is now or shall hereafter be authorized, all vehicles parked thereon shall be parked with the front thereof nearest the curb.

#### §523-35 Loading zones.

The locations described in Schedule XX (§523-129), attached to and made a part of this chapter, are hereby designated as loading zones. No person shall park a vehicle in said locations other than for the loading or unloading of goods and materials.

§523-37 Bus stops.

The locations described in Schedule XXII (§523-131), attached to and made a part of this chapter, are hereby designated as bus stops. **No person shall park, stop, or stand a vehicle in said locations other than a bus actively picking up or discharging passengers.** 

#### §523-38 Restricted handicap parking spaces.

- A. The locations described in Schedule XXIXA (§523-138A), attached to and made a part of this chapter, are hereby designated as restricted parking spaces reserved for use by handicapped persons, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-197.5.
- **BA**. The locations describedlisted in Schedule XXIXB (§523-138B), attached to and made a part of this chapter, are hereby designated as restricted parking spaces reserved for use by a specific person in front of a certain residence, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-197.6.
- C. The restricted handicap parking spaces described in Schedule XXIXA and Schedule XXIXB shall be reserved for use by handicapped persons who havehas been issued special vehicle identification cards by the Motor Vehicle Commission Division of Motor Vehicles, pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 39:4-205, when using a motor vehicle on which is displayed a certificate for which a special vehicle identification card has been issued, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-206. All spaces indicated hereby shall be painted and signed in accordance with the applicable regulations issued from time to time by the State of New Jersey Department of Transportation.
- D. Application; fees; approval; term and renewal.
  - (1) Persons seeking a dedicated handicap parking space under §523-38B shall complete an application on forms provided by the Police Department and must possess a valid special vehicle identification card and show proof of residency at the requested location.
  - (2) Fees for application review shall be paid as described in §55-15. If the application is approved, further fees for the cost of signage installation shall be paid as described in §55-16. There shall be no fee required for renewal per §523-38D(4).
  - (3) In completing its investigation and review, the Police Department shall only recommend approval if there is no on-site parking available and shall specify the recommended placement of signage. The Mayor and Council shall maintain final approval authority, which shall be effectuated by amendment of Schedule XXIXB (§523-138B). Under no circumstances shall a restricted handicap parking space be recommended or placed in any location where parking is otherwise prohibited.
  - (4) Restricted handicap parking spaces authorized under §523-38B shall be valid January 1 to December 31. In December of each year, applicants shall be required to submit a renewal form with updated proof of residency, proof of a valid special vehicle identification card, and such other information as may be required by the Police Department. If not received by December 31, the Police Department shall send a certified letter to the applicant requesting the renewal form and notifying them of the potential removal of the dedicated handicap parking space. Denial of said renewal by the Police Department or failure to submit for renewal by March 31 of any year may result in the

# removal of the space from Schedule XXIXB (§523-138B) and the removal of associated signage.

#### **E**C. Change in residence.

- (1) If any person for whom a parking space has been designated pursuant to this section ceases to reside at the specified resident address, he or she shall promptly notify the Borough Clerk in writing that the designated parking space is no longer required.
- (2) In the event that the person holding the designated handicapped parking permit no longer resides at the specified residence address, the designation may be terminated by **ordinance**resolution.

# FB. Violations and penalties; schedule of restricted handicap parking spaces.

- (1) Any person parking a motor vehicle in a parking space restricted for use to persons who have been issued special vehicle identification cards or wheelchair symbol license plates by the **Motor Vehicle Commission** Division of Motor Vehicles without such a special vehicle identification card or wheelchair symbol license plate shall be liable to a fine of \$250 for the first offense and, for subsequent offenses, a fine of at least \$250 and up to 90 days' community service on such terms and in such form as the court shall deem appropriate, or any combination thereof. This penalty provision shall apply to vehicles parked on public or private property.
- (2) This penalty provision shall apply to vehicles parked on public or private property. Article XII of Chapter 523 of the Code of the Borough of Roselle is amended by adding the following new section: § 523-138, Schedule XXIX: Restricted Handicap Parking Spaces.

#### SECTION IV. Amendments to Article V Emergency No Parking

Chapter 523 "Vehicles and Traffic," Article V "Emergency No Parking" of the Code of the Borough of Roselle is hereby amended as follows (additions in **bold**, deletions struck through):

#### §523-53 Designation of snow emergency no-parking areas.

A. Whenever snow has fallen and the accumulation is such that it covers the street or highway, no vehicle shall be parked on either side of any of the streets or parts thereof described in Schedule XXV (§523-134), attached to and made a part of this chapter.

#### §523-54 Posting of signs.

A. Upon the declaration of an emergency, there shall be no parking upon streets or sections of streets when temporary EMERGENCY NO PARKING signs are displayed. The Chief of Police, or in his absence the ranking police officer, is authorized to declare an emergency and to direct the posting of said EMERGENCY NO PARKING signs when weather conditions, accidents, fires, roadwork, construction, other work within the right-ofway, or public celebrations dictate or require the avoidance of hazards or other conditions which interfere with the free flow of traffic.

#### SECTION V. Repeal of Article VII Traffic Control Signal Monitoring System

Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-8.18 and the expiration of New Jersey's five-year pilot program for traffic control signal monitoring systems in 2014, Chapter 523 "Vehicles and Traffic," Article VII "Traffic Control Signal Monitoring System" of the Code of the Borough of Roselle is hereby repealed and removed in its entirety.

#### **SECTION VI. Amendments to Article XII Schedules**

Chapter 523 "Vehicles and Traffic," Article XII "Schedules" of the Code of the Borough of Roselle is hereby amended as follows (additions in **bold**, deletions struck through):
