To Whom It May Concern:

At a legal meeting of the registered voters of the Town of Salisbury, held at the Salisbury Elementary School on October 23, 2023 the meeting was called to order at 7:26 p.m. with a quorum being present of 125 registered voters. The following action was taken under Article Twenty-Four:

## ARTICLE TWENTY-FOUR

To see if the town will vote to amend the General Bylaws of the Town, Chapter 30, Article V, §30-19 (Agricultural Commission) by inserting the text shown in bold as follows:

The Agricultural Commission shall serve as facilitators for encouraging the pursuit of agriculture in Salisbury and promote agricultural-based economic opportunities in the Town. The Commission shall consist of five members and one alternate member, appointed by the Board of Selectmen. The Commission shall consist of a minimum of three members who are actively involved in farming in Salisbury and another two members and one alternate member who are interested in farming. The initial appointments shall include three members who shall be appointed for a term of three years and two members for a term of two years. Thereafter, all appointments, including that of the alternate member, shall be made for three-year terms. The Board of Selectmen, as the appointing authority, shall fill any vacancy on the Commission based on the unexpired term of the vacancy in order to maintain the cycle of appointments; or to take any other action relative thereto ON PETITION OF THE TOWN MANAGER
