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 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 600.020 OF THE CITY CODE TO ADD
 CONSUMPTION LICENSES TO THE CLASSES OF LIQUOR LICENSES REQUIRED FOR
 BUSINESSES WHICH ALLOW LIQUOR TO BE CONSUMED ON ITS PREMISES BY
 CUSTOMERS

WHEREAS, the City of Valley Park seeks to require liquor licenses for entertainment businesses which allow customers to consume liquor on their premises during the course of their normal business.

WHEREAS, the City of Valley Park desires to include the Consumption of Liquor definition as found in Missouri statute section 311.480 RSMo. to ensure the city code remains in line with state statute.

WHEREAS, the City of Valley Park, after due consideration, desires to amend the City Code Chapter 600. Alcoholic Beverages, Section 600.020 License Required—Classes of Licenses to include provisions for a consumption of liquor license.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Valley Park, Missouri as follows:

Section One

Section 600.020 shall be amended to read as follows:

A. No person shall sell or offer for sale intoxicating liquor in the City of Valley Park without a currently valid liquor license issued by the City. A separate liquor license shall be required for each of the categories and subcategories of liquor sales in which the licensee desires to engage as set forth herein. **In addition, it shall be unlawful for any person operating any premises where food, beverages or entertainment are sold or provided for compensation, who does not possess a license for the sale of intoxicating liquor, to permit the drinking or consumption of intoxicating liquor in the premises, without having a license as provided in this section.**

B. *General Licenses.* Any person possessing the qualifications and meeting the requirements of this Chapter may apply for the following licenses to sell intoxicating liquor:

1. *Package liquor — malt liquor only:* Sales of malt liquor at retail by grocers and other merchants and dealers for sale in the original package direct to consumers but not for resale and not for consumption on the premises where sold. This license may include Sunday sales from 9:00 A.M. to Midnight.

2. *Package liquor — all kinds*: Sales of all kinds of intoxicating liquors in the original package at retail not for consumption on the premises where sold, including sales as set forth in Subsection (B)(1) of this Section.

3. *Liquor by the drink — malt liquor/light wine only*: Sales of malt liquor and light wines at retail by the drink for consumption on the premises where sold, including sales as set forth in Subsections (B)(1) and (4) of this Section.

4. *Malt liquor by the drink*: Sales of malt liquor at retail by the drink for consumption on the premises. This license may include Sunday sales from 9:00 A.M. to Midnight.

5. *Liquor by the drink — all kinds*: Sales of intoxicating liquor of all kinds at retail by the drink for consumption on the premises where sold, including package sales as set forth in Subsection (B)(2) of this Section.

6. Consumption of Liquor—all kinds; Consumption of intoxicating liquor of all kinds on any premises where food, beverages or entertainment are sold or provided for compensation between the hours of 6:00 A.M. to 1:30 A.M. every day of the week.

Section Two

This Ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage and upon its approval by the Mayor.




