

## RESOLUTION HONORING OFFICER DANIEL SADOWSKI UPON HIS RETIREMENT

WHEREAS, Officer Daniel S. Sadowski was hired as a police officer for the Township of Warrington on June 22, 1998; and

WHEREAS, Officer Sadowski is an Academically Accredited officer, having served on the Department's first Highway Unit specializing in accident reconstruction, highway drug interdiction, traffic and DUI enforcement; and

WHEREAS, Officer Sadowski is a highly decorated officer who has served as a Field Training Officer, DARE officer, Crisis Intervention team and Officer in Charge of the Department Honor Guard and has received numerous letters of recognition, commendations, and awards throughout his career; and

WHEREAS, Officer Sadowski was selected to become an original member of the Bucks County Major Incident Response Team which was formed following the 9/11 attacks, and served as a twenty year member the Southeast Region Joint Terrorism Task Force as a team leader in counter terrorism and field force operations; and

WHEREAS, Officer Daniel Sadowski retired from the Warrington Township Police Department on February 15, 2023 after twenty-four years of service.
