**MINUTES OF TOWN MEETING****June 26, 2017**

First Selectman J. Christopher Kervick called the Meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

Upon nomination by Board of Finance Chairman Paul Harrington and second by Board of Finance Alternate Mark Whitten, Joseph R. Calsett a, 121 Orchard Hill Drive, was unanimously elected Moderator on a voice vote.

Mr. Kervick, with a second by Selectman Rick Rachele, presented the following resolution and moved its adoption:
