5 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WOODSON TERRACE, MISSOURI
6 CALLING FOR AN ELECTION, TO SEEK VOTER APPROVAL FOR THE
7 ADOPTION OF A BUSINESS LICENSE FEE TO BE ASSESSED FOR ATM
8 OPERATORS THAT ARE OWNED BY ENTITIES OTHER THAN BANKS,
9 TRUST COMPANIES, SAVINGS AND LOAN OR CREDIT UNIONS;
10 WHICH ENTITIES ARE ALREADY SUBJECT TO THE REQUIREMENT
11 TO PAY A BUSINESS LICENSE FEE TO THE CITY.

13 WHEREAS, pursuant to the Hancock Amendment, the Board of Aldermen wishes to call
14 for an election for the adoption of a business license fee, in the amount of five hundred dollars
15 (\$500) for each automated teller machine ("ATM") located within the City, when owned by
16 entities other than banks, trust companies, savings and loan or credit unions. Such entities are
17 already subject to the \$500 business license fee pursuant to Section 605.290 of the City's
18 Municipal Code; and

20 WHEREAS, the City is authorized to levy such a license fee pursuant to Section 94.270
21 RSMo; and

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE
24 CITY OF WOODSON TERRACE, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

26 Section One.

27
28 The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to do all things necessary to submit
29 substantially the following question to the voters of the City of Woodson Terrace at the 2nd day of
30 April, 2024, general municipal election, to wit:

31 Proposition A

32 Shall the City of Woodson Terrace, Missouri, be authorized to levy a business
33 license fee of \$500 per Automated Teller Machine ("ATM") located in the City.
34 The approval of this proposition would result in the extension of this business
35 license fee which is already payable by banks, trust companies, savings and loan or
36 credit unions pursuant to Section 605.290 of the City's Municipal Code, to ATM
37 owners that are other types of entities.

2 If a majority of the voters voting thereon approve the proposal, the City may enact an
3 ordinance for the collection and administration of such tax.



7 statutes, and the ordinances of the City of Woodson Terrace, Missouri, a Municipal election shall
8 be held on Tuesday, April 2nd, 2024.

11 This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by
12 the Mayor.


