ORDINANCE NO. 2010-07**

**ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE
BOROUGH OF WRIGHTSTOWN AMENDING CHAPTER 132, BEING THE
PARKS AND RECREATION AREAS CHAPTER, OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES
OF THE BOROUGH OF WRIGHTSTOWN**

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Wrightstown, County of Burlington and State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1: Chapter 132, Parks and Recreation Areas, of the Codified Ordinances of the Borough of Wrightstown shall be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

...

§ 132-3. Hours Designated for Opening and Closing.

Except for lighted sports activities, parks shall be open to the public every day of the year from dawn until dusk.

...

§ 132-5. Application for Permit.

Permits for special events in parks shall be obtained by application to the Borough Council in accordance with the following procedure:

- A. A person seeking issuance of a permit hereunder shall file an application with the Borough Council stating:
- (1) The name and address of the applicant.
 - (2) The name and address of the person, persons, corporation or association sponsoring the activity, if any.
 - (3) The day and hours for which the permit is desired.
 - (4) The park or portion thereof for which such permit is desired.
 - (5) The activity to be undertaken or purpose of the application.
 - (5) Any other information which the Borough Council shall find reasonably necessary to a fair determination as to whether a permit should be issued hereunder.

...

§ 132-9. Liability of Permittee.

The person or persons to whom the permit is issued shall be liable for all loss, damage or injury sustained by any person whatever by reason of the negligence of the person or persons to whom such permit shall have been issued. Each permittee must have a liability insurance policy limit of at least \$100,000 covering injuries to members of

the general public arising out of such permitted activities. The Borough Council shall have the right to require permittees to submit evidence of said liability insurance coverage.

Section 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of their inconsistency.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after proper passage, publication, and approval as provided by law.

The ordinance published herewith was introduced and passed upon first reading at the regular meeting of the Borough Council of the Borough of Wrightstown held on September 8, 2010.
