

TOWNSHIP OF HAMILTON
ORDINANCE NO. 1821—2016

AN ORDINANCE REARRANGING TRAFFIC SIGNALS LOCATED AT THE INTERSECTION OF VENICE BOULEVARD, CHURCH STREET & ASPEN STREET.

WHEREAS, Office Wade Smith, the Traffic Coordinator of the Township of Hamilton Police Department has issued a memorandum recommending a rearrangement of the traffic signals located at the intersection of Venice Boulevard, Church Street, and Aspen Street (the “Intersection”); and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee has reviewed said memorandum and adopts its findings and recommendations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Hamilton, County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey, that:

SECTION I. AMENDING TOWNSHIP CODE SECTION 301-27B

The following shall be added to Section 301-27B of the Township Code:

Through Streets	Stop Streets
Venice Boulevard	Aspen Street
Venice Boulevard	Church Street

SECTION II. DIRECTION TO PUBLIC WORKS TO REARRANGE SIGNALS

The Department of Public Works shall remove the stop sign from eastbound Venice Boulevard at the Intersection and place stop signs in accordance with MUTCD standards on the Church Street and Aspen Street approaches to the Intersection.

The Department of Public Works shall additionally paint a 24-inch “stop bar” on the Aspen Street approach to the Intersection.

SECTION III. NOTIFICATION OF CHANGE

The Police Department and the Department of Public Works shall coordinate notifications to be made as follows:

- (a) Mobile Message Boards in the vicinity of the Intersection;
- (b) NIXLE Broadcasts; and
- (c) the Township of Hamilton website.

SECTION IV. SEVERABILITY and REPEALER

- (a) If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, invalid, or enforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.
- (b) Any Ordinance inconsistent with the terms of this Ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency

SECTION V. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall take effect upon its final passage and publication as provided by law.
