- **Resolution 38-2016** – A Resolution ratifying the submission of a grant application to Federal Emergency Management Agency on behalf of the Bureau of Fire for the purpose of funding a Fire Prevention and Safety Program that includes a door-to-door education campaign and the installation of 3,000 smoke alarms in City residences.
