ORDINANCES FOR FINAL PASSAGE

- **Bill 21-2016** – An Ordinance to amend and update Section 4-105.2 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Harrisburg relating to unlawful housing and commercial property practices by adding protection against source of income discrimination for residents with a verifiable source of legal income.
- **Bill 24-2016** – An Ordinance amending Chapter 6-331 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Harrisburg, which prohibits smoking in all buildings, vehicles, and playgrounds owned, leased or operated by the City of Harrisburg, to include pools owned, leased or operated by the City of Harrisburg.
