ORDINANCES FOR FIRST READING

- **Bill 26-2016** - An Ordinance amending Title 8 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Harrisburg by deleting the existing Chapter 8-511 titled "Residential Rental Unit Permit Program" in its entirety, including associated permit fees and penalties, and replacing it with a new Chapter 8-511 titled "Residential Rental Unit Registration Program," requiring the registration of all residential rental units throughout the City, providing for fees and penalties related to the administration of the program.

- **Bill 17-2016** – An Ordinance amending Chapter 11-101 of the Codified Ordinances of Harrisburg entitled “Foreclosure Property Registry and Maintenance” changing the annual \$200 registration fee requirement to a bi-annual fee.
