

CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 2024-05

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ORGANIZATION OF THE VILLAGE
§5-9 (B.) BOARDS, COMMISSIONS, AND COMMITTEES
REMOVE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE

The Village Board of the Village of Allouez, Brown County, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. That this Ordinance shall constitute a charter ordinance as defined by §66.0101(1m), Wisconsin Statutes, and shall not take effect until sixty days after its passage and publication as a Class 1 notice; and, in the event that within such sixty-day period a Petition signed by a number of electors of the Village equal to not less than 7% of the votes cast within the Village of Allouez for Governor at the last general election shall be filed in the office of the Clerk-Treasurer of this Village demanding that this Ordinance be submitted to a vote of the electors, this Ordinance shall not take effect until submitted to a referendum and approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon.

SECTION 2. That the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Allouez is hereby amended to read as follows:

§5-9 Boards, Commissions, and committees.

B. Creation. The following boards, commissions and committees are created to perform such duties as required by the Wisconsin Statutes, rules and regulations, the Village ordinances, and as determined by the Village Board from time to time:

- (1) Village Plan Commission is established under the provisions of §62.23(1), Wis. Stats., and hereby vested with such authority as specified in state statutes.
- (2) Parks, Recreation and Forestry Committee.
- (3) Public Works Committee.
- ~~(4) Economic Development Committee.~~
- (4) ~~(5)~~ Board of Appeals.
- (5) ~~(6)~~ Board of Review.
- (6) ~~(7)~~ Ethics Board.
- (7) ~~(8)~~ Historic Preservation Commission.

SECTION 3. That pursuant to §66.0101(2)(a), Wis. Stats., the enactment of this charter ordinance requires a two-thirds vote of the members-elect of the legislative body of the Village.
