## Local Law No. 7 of the year 2022

A local law to amend parking limits in certain of the Municipal Fields and to expand the Downtown Resident Parking Area

## Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Amityville as follows:

Section 1. The Board of Trustees adopted Local Law No 4 of 2020 to modify parking limits in certain municipal parking fields and established a Downtown Resident Parking Permit in anticipation of increased off-street parking demand from downtown residential expansion. The Board finds that such law needs to be amended to successfully implement this program by clarifying the parking limits, and by expanding the area for Downtown Resident Parking to include a portion of Park Avenue.

Section 2. § 172-39 B. of the Code of the Village of Amityville is hereby amended to read as follows:

- "B. There is hereby established a Downtown Resident Parking Permit to be issued to a village resident actually occupying a residential dwelling unit located within 250' of Broadway (NYS Rt. 110) between Avon Place and Railroad Avenue on the following conditions:
- 1. The applicant for the permit must provide proof of current residency within the designated area.
- 2. No more than one (1) permit will be issued per person, and no more than two (2) permits per dwelling unit, regardless of the number of persons residing therein.
- 3. Downtown Permit parking shall be restricted to Municipal Parking Fields 3,4,5,9,10,14, and 15, and shall be open to permit holders on an "as available" basis".

Section 3. §172-63 of the Code of the Village of Amityville is hereby amended to read as follows:

"§ 172-63. Schedule XVI: Municipal Parking Fields.

In accordance with the provisions of § 172-38, the following are designated as municipal parking fields:
