OFFICIAL BOROUGH OF BADEN ORDINANCE NO. 963

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF BADEN, COUNTY OF BEAVER AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 961 BY ADDING PROVISIONS WHICH PROHIBIT SMOKING AND THE USE OF TOBACCO PRODUCTS IN PUBLIC PARKS AND PLAYGROUNDS

WHEREAS, the Borough of Baden Council has heretofore enacted into law Ordinance No. 961, which, interalia, prohibits smoking in enclosed areas owned or under the control of the Borough; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the use of tobacco products (as that term is defined herein) in the proximity of children, youth and adults engaging in or watching recreational activities is unhealthy and detrimental to the health of others.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ORDAINED and ENACTED as follows:

Section I:

That Section 1-1 of Ordinance No. 961 entitled "Definitions" is hereby amended to include the following additional definition:

"TOBACCO" is defined to include any lighted or unlighted cigarette, cigar, pipe, and any other smoking product; and spit tobacco, also known as smokeless, dip, chew, spit less, snus and snuff, in any form; including, but not limited to, non-FDA approved cessation nicotine products, digital/electronic nicotine delivery systems e.g. "e-cigarette," vapor products or anything that simulates or can be construed as being a smoking or smokeless tobacco product (i.e., herbal smoking products).

Section II:

That Section 1-2 of Ordinance No. 961 entitled "Smoking Prohibited" is hereby amended to include the following additional provision:

The use of Tobacco and smoking is also prohibited in and on all parks, playgrounds and any other recreational facilities owned or under the control of the Borough. Further, that "Young Lungs at Play" signs shall be placed at all parks, playgrounds and other recreational facilities owned or under the control of the Borough (an image of said sign is attached hereto and is marked Exhibit "A").
