## ORDINANCE 05-24

## ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR VARIOUS IMPROVEMENTS TO BE UNDERTAKEN IN AND BY THE TOWN OF BOONTON, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY, AND APPROPRIATING \$492,400 THEREFOR FROM VARIOUS FUNDS OF THE TOWN.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BOONTON, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The improvements described in Section 2 of this ordinance are hereby authorized as general improvements to be made or acquired by the Town of Boonton, New Jersey. For the said improvements or purposes stated in said Section 2, there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$492,400, to the extent of \$406,200, from moneys available in the Capital Improvement Fund of the Town, to the extent of \$40,000, from moneys available in the Reserve for Sale of Assets of the Town, and to the extent of \$46,200, from a New Jersey Department of Transportation Grant as a grant-in-aid for the stormwater management project.

Section 2. The improvements hereby authorized and the several purposes for which said appropriation is made are as follows: (a) the acquisition by purchase of new and additional equipment including, without limitation, a traffic message board and a lawn mower for use by the Department of Public Works of the Town, swift water rescue equipment, body armor, taser equipment, a fleet camera system, and cameras for use by the Police Department of the Town, selfcontained breathing apparatus, air cylinders, a washing machine and dryer for use by the Fire Department of the Town; and (b) the improvement of various Town facilities including, without limitation, the Senior Center by the installation of a door access control system, the municipal pickleball courts by the construction and finishes thereof, Town Hall by the renovation thereof and the installation of new soffits, Council Chambers by the installation of a stormwater management plan, initial costs associated with the improvement of the Main Street wall, and including also, record retention and archiving systems, together with for all the aforesaid all equipment, accessories, attachments, work and materials, necessary therefor or incidental thereto, all as shown on and in accordance with the plans and specifications therefor on file or to be filed in the office of the Town Clerk and hereby approved.

Section 3. The capital budget or temporary capital budget of the Town is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing all detail of the amended capital budget or temporary capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services are on file with the Town Clerk and are available for public inspection.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect after publication after final adoption, as provided by law.
