ORDINANCE 2020-20

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SCHEDULE II ATTENDANT TO BOROUGH CODE SECTION 9.3.4 OF CHAPTER 9: "TRAFFIC" TO REVISE THE HOURS OF CERTAIN NO PARKING ZONES ON NEWARK AVENUE TO FURTHER ENHANCE SAFETY DURING GARBAGE COLLECTION

Mayor Engelstad offered the following Ordinance and moved its introduction:

WHEREAS, the Borough DPW Director brought to the Mayor & Council's attention potential public safety hazards during garbage collection on Newark Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council previously and recently amended the Borough Code to address traffic safety during garbage collection on Newark Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the Borough DPW Director recommends adjusting the hours attendant to the Borough's prior Ordinance to better comport with garbage collection timing; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council desire to revise the no parking zones on Newark Avenue for the foregoing purpose;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Bradley Beach, County of Monmouth, and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1. "Schedule II" attendant to Section 9-3.4 entitled "Parking Prohibited At All Times On Certain Streets" of Chapter 9: "Traffic" of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Bradley Beach is hereby amended as follows (~~stricken text~~ indicates deletions, underlined text indicates additions):

Newark Avenue	Southerly	7 <u>11</u> :00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. <u>2:00 p.m.</u> Tuesday and Friday	Beginning at a point of 18 feet from the easterly curbline of Madison Avenue and extending in an easterly direction for distance of 42 feet.

Beginning at a point of 157 feet west from the westerly curbline of Central Avenue and extending in an westerly direction for distance of 22 feet.


SECTION 3. If any article, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance and they shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. In the event of any inconsistencies between the provisions of this Ordinance and any prior ordinance of the Borough, the provisions hereof shall be determined to govern. All other parts, portions and provisions of The Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Bradley Beach are hereby ratified and confirmed, except where inconsistent with the terms hereof.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect upon adoption and publication in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey.
