Village of Camillus, Onondaga County, New York

Local Law No. 1 of the year 2024

A local law to amend Chapter 100 of the Code of the Village of Camillus by repealing and replacing Article VII regarding partial real property tax exemptions for persons with disabilities and limited incomes.

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees as follows:

The Code of The Village of Camillus shall be amended by repealing Article VII of Chapter 100 in its entirety and replacing with the following

"ARTICLE VII

Partial Real Property Tax Exemptions for Persons with Disabilities and Limited Incomes

§100-50

A. Pursuant to the provisions of and definitions set forth in §459-c of the Real Property Tax Law, as amended from time to time, real property located in the Village which is owned by one or more persons with disabilities, or real property owned by a husband, wife or both, or by siblings, at least wone of whom has a disability, and whose income as hereafter defined is limited by reason of such disability, shall be exempt from taxation by the Village to the extent provided in the following schedule:

Percent of Exemption Based on Assessment	Exemption Income Not More Than
50%	\$50,000
45%	\$51,000
40%	\$52,000
35%	\$53,000
30%	\$53,900
25%	\$54,800
20%	\$55,700
15%	\$56,600
10%	\$57,500
5%	\$58,400"
