AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 78 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF CLAYTON (SEWERS)

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Clayton as

follows:

Section 1. Chapter 78, Section 37(A) is hereby amended to read as follows:

§ 78-37 (A) Schedule of annual rates; senior citizens' reduction.

A. Residential sewer connections shall be charged at an annual rate of five hundred and forty-two (\$542.00) dollars per domestic consumer unit, defined as follows:

Section 3. Chapter 78, Section 37(D)(1) is hereby amended to read as follows:

- D. Heavy commercial and industrial customers.
- (1) Heavy commercial and industrial customers shall be billed based on water consumption as follows:
 - (a) Up to twenty-four thousand (24,000) gallons per quarter: one hundred and thirty-five dollars and fifty cents. (\$135.50).
 - (b) Per one thousand (1,000) gallons above twenty-four thousand (24,000): four dollars and fifty cents (\$4.50).

Section 4. Chapter 78, Section 37(E)(1) is hereby amended to read as follows:

- E. Additional charges
- 1. Item Quarterly Charge

Garbage disposal \$19.00

Floor drain \$76.00

Section 5. Chapter 78, Section 37(F) is hereby amended to read as follows:

F. Senior citizens [age sixty-five (65) years or more] having an annual income not in excess of the limitations provided in N.J.S.A. 54:48.40 et seq., which provides for real estate tax deductions, and residing in a dwelling house owned by such senior citizen shall be charged at an annual rate of three hundred and twenty-six dollars (\$326.00) dollars per domestic consumer unit. Determination of eligibility for the reduced rate provided for herein shall be made in accordance with the standards in effect for determining real estate tax deductions under the provisions of N.J.S.A. 54:48.40 et seq., as said section shall be amended from time to time, together with any applicable regulations promulgated thereunder.

Section 6. Article II, Chapter 78, Section 78-36 (A) and (B)(1) is hereby

amended to read as follows:
