§ 270-14 Parking reserved in designated locations.

A. Accessible parking. Parking shall be reserved in the following locations for persons with disabilities who have been issued a parking permit or license plate for persons with disabilities by a local government or state agency:

(1) Doubleday Parking Lot.

- (a) Two parking spaces in the northwest section of Doubleday Parking Lot along its property line with the east side of the building at 137 Main Street.
- (b) Three parking spaces in the northeast section of Doubleday Parking Lot and parallel to the building at 103 Main Street.

(2) Fish Road:

- (a) The first parking space north of the boat wash station on the west side of Fish Road.
- (b) The northernmost parking spot on the west side of Fish Road.

(3) Main Street.

- (a) The parking space on the south side of Main Street immediately east of Chestnut Street with a 2 hour time limit.
- (b) The parking space on the south side of Main Street immediately east of Pioneer Alley with a 2 hour time limit.
- (c) The parking space on the south side of Main Street immediately east of Pioneer Street with a 2 hour time limit.

- (d) The easternmost parking space on the south side of Main Street in front of National Baseball Hall of Fame and Museum and nearest the crosswalk with a 2 hour time limit.
- (e) The parking space on the north side of Main Street immediately east of Chestnut Street with a 2 hour time limit.
- (f) The parking space on the north side of Main Street in front of 100 Main Street to the east of the curb cut with a 2 hour time limit.
- (g) The parking space on the north side of Main Street immediately west of Pioneer Street with a 2 hour time limit.
- (h) The parking space on the north side of Main Street east of Hoffman Lane in front of the U.S. Post Office and nearest the crosswalk with a 30 minute time limit.

(4) Pioneer Street.

- (a) The two northernmost parking spaces on the east side of Pioneer Street adjacent to Lakefront Park.




