Amend Chapter 270 – Vehicle and Traffic as follows:

270-3 (A) traffic control signal shall be maintained and operated as follows:

A pre-timed traffic control signal at the intersection of Main Street and Chestnut Street, consisting of a three-section, four-face signal head.

ADD: at end of sentence ..., post-mounted three-section signal heads, and post-mounted pedestrian signals.”

270-12 The parking of vehicles is hereby prohibited in the following locations:

ADD:

Chestnut West From the corner of Main Street and Chestnut Street to the driveway adjacent to
Street the building located at 22 Chestnut Street

270-13 (B) The parking of vehicles is hereby prohibited for a period longer than 15 minutes in the following locations:

REMOVE:

Chestnut West From the corner of Main Street and Chestnut Street to the driveway adjacent to
Street the building located at 22 Chestnut Street

270-14 (A) Accessible parking.

DELETE:

(11) One two-hour handicapped parking space on Upper Main Street (between Chestnut Street and the parking lot directly adjacent to 183 Main Street), replacing two-hour parking spaces in the vicinity of 169-171 Main Street.

270-14 (E) Parking shall be reserved for delivery truck unloading:

Parking shall be reserved for delivery truck unloading Monday to Saturday, 6am to 12pm in the following locations. Outside of those days and times, these locations shall accommodate vehicular parking in conformity with regulations elsewhere in this chapter.

ADD:

(6) On south side of Main Street west of Chestnut Street for a length of 60 feet.

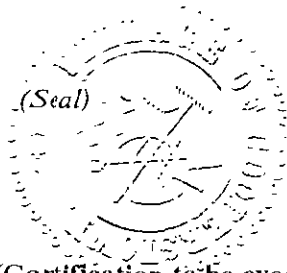
