270-14(D) Fowler Way parking lot.

(1) During the period from the day following Columbus Day until the Friday before Memorial Day, the following regulations will be in effect: Parking shall be reserved for buses and RV/boat trailers on the east side of parking lot as delineated by signage located in the Village-owned portion of Fowler Way parking lot located behind the Cooperstown Chamber of Commerce and further identified by Tax Map No. 131.06-2-14.01. Parking shall be reserved for passenger vehicles and RVs on the west side of the lot as delineated by signage, and on the north end of the same lot parking shall be reserved for passenger vehicles. Three fifteen-minute parking spaces shall be designated on the south side (facing north) of said lot and one shall be designated for handicapped accessibility only. Overnight parking for passenger vehicles shall be permitted from the day following Columbus Day until the Friday before Memorial Day. From November 1 through April 1, overnight parking for passenger vehicles may be permitted only in the area of this lot to be designated for overnight parking by appropriate signage.

(2) During the period from the Saturday before Memorial Day to Columbus Day, the following regulations will be in effect: Parking shall be reserved for passenger vehicles only in the parking lot located in the Village-owned portion of the Fowler Way parking lot located behind the Cooperstown Chamber of Commerce and further identified by Tax Map No. 131.06-2-14.01. Only passenger vehicles that have a Village of Cooperstown issued parking permit may park in the lot, with the exception of three 15-minute parking spaces designated on the south side (facing north) of said lot and one designated for handicapped accessibility only. Parking in the lot is prohibited between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m.

270-14(D) Fowler Way parking lot.

- (1) The Fowler Way parking lot is located east of the Cooperstown Chamber of Commerce and identified by Tax Map No. 131.06-2-14.01.
- (2) At all times, the four northern most spaces on the east side of the Fowler Way are reserved for use by electric or hybrid electric vehicles engaged in vehicle charging. No permit is required for EV charging.
- (3) During the period from the day following Columbus Day through the Friday before Memorial Day, the following regulations will be in effect:
 - a. South of the EV charging spaces on the east side, parking is reserved for buses and RVs as delineated by signage.
 - b. Parking is reserved for passenger vehicles and RVs on the west side of the lot as delineated by signage.

- c. Parking is reserved for passenger vehicles on the north end and in the center row.
 - d. From November 1 through April 1, overnight parking for passenger vehicles is permitted only in the area of this lot designated for overnight parking by signage.
- (4) During the period from the Saturday before Memorial Day to Columbus Day, the following regulations will be in effect:
- a. Parking is reserved for passenger vehicles only.
 - b. Except for the designated EV charging spaces, only passenger vehicles that have a Village of Cooperstown issued parking permit may park in the lot.
 - c. Parking in the lot is prohibited between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m. except in the designated EV charging spaces.
