

ORDINANCE NO. 2/24

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COTTLEVILLE, MISSOURI, AMENDING TABLE III-A OF SCHEDULE III OF TITLE III OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF COTTLEVILLE; PROHIBITING PARKING ON CERTAIN SECTIONS OF ST CHARLES STREET; AND AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION OF NO PARKING SIGNS BY THE TRAFFIC ENGINEER

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen of the City of Cottleville, Missouri (the “City”) recognizes that traffic can and should be controlled on certain streets within the City in order to promote the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen of the City desires to provide improved safety at all times for residents of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen finds and determines that prohibiting parking on certain sections of St Charles Street will promote traffic safety within the City;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF COTTLEVILLE, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That Table III-A of Schedule III of Title III of the Municipal Code of the City of Cottleville, Missouri, be and is hereby amended by adding the following:

<i>Location</i>	<i>Restriction</i>
The south side of St Charles Street, heading east, beginning at its intersection with Highway N and continuing until Fifth Street	Unlawful to park any vehicle, trailer or other object
The north side of St Charles Street, heading east, beginning at its intersection with Highway N and continuing east for a distance of 75 feet.	Unlawful to park any vehicle, trailer or other object

SECTION 2. The City Traffic Engineer is hereby authorized and directed to erect and install appropriate signs giving notice of the parking restriction described in Section 1 of this Ordinance, at such locations to be determined by the City Traffic Engineer, in his/her sole discretion.


SECTION 4. Savings Clause: Except as expressly set forth herein, nothing contained in this Ordinance shall in any manner be deemed or construed to alter, modify, supersede, supplant or otherwise nullify any other Ordinance of the City or the requirements thereof whether or not relating to or in any manner connected with the subject matter hereof.

SECTION 5. Severability Clause: If any term, condition, or provision of this Ordinance shall, to any extent, be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the remainder hereof shall be valid in all other respects and continue to be effective and each and every remaining provision hereof shall be valid and shall be enforced to the fullest extent permitted by law, it being the intent of the Board of Aldermen that it would have enacted this Ordinance without the invalid or unenforceable provisions. In the event of a subsequent change in applicable law so that the provision which had been held invalid is no longer invalid, said provision shall thereupon return to full force and effect without further action by the City and shall thereafter be binding.

SECTION 6. Effective Date: This Ordinance shall be in full force and take effect from and after its final passage and approval.


