TOWN OF CUMBERLAND

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES REGARDING
NOTICE OF VACANCY ON BOARD OR COMMISSION

The Town of Cumberland ordains:

Section 1. Article IV of Chapter 2 of the Cumberland Code of Ordinances entitled “Boards, Commissions, Committees and Subcommittees” is hereby amended to add the following provision:

§ 2-81 Notice of vacancy or expiration of term.

Whenever the term of any position on any board, commission, committee or subcommittee shall expire, or whenever a position becomes vacant during a term requiring appointment, the Town Clerk shall cause notice be placed on the Town’s website on the home page as well as any applicable department pages. Notice shall include the title and description of the open position, approximate time commitment on a monthly basis, dates of regular meetings (e.g., second Tuesday of each month), and stipend if applicable.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and all other ordinances and/or resolutions inconsistent herewith are repealed.



This Ordinance amends the requirements for notice of openings for boards, commission, committees and subcommittees.
