**ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE REORGANIZATION OF THE  
DEPTFORD POLICE DEPARTMENT**


**WHEREAS**, the Township of Deptford has a Police Department; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief of Police has recommended that the Township reorganize and promote certain members of the Police Department pursuant to State Law and Judicial decisions.


**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Council of the Township of Deptford as follows:

1. The Deptford Township Police Department organizational structure will now include the following positions: one (1) Chief of Police; one (1) Deputy Chief of Police; two (2) Captains; five (5) Lieutenants; eight (8) Sergeants; and up to sixty-three (63) Police Officers. This will bring the total authorized police force up to eighty (80) sworn Police Officers.
2. These appointments are subject to the discretion of the Township Manager and the required available budget appropriations for each position by the Township Council.
3. That this Ordinance shall be effected twenty (20) days after final adoption And publication as provided by law.


