AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 0.3.04 "POLICE DEPARTMENT ORGANIZATION" TO CREATE THE POSITION OF POLICE CHAPLAIN

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A 40A:14-141 provides for the appointment of Chaplain to the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has recommended that such position be created;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Deptford, County of Gloucester that Ordinance O.3.04 "Police Department Organization" is hereby amended as follows:

Section 1:	The position of Chaplain is hereby created in the Deptford
	Township Police Department. Any person appointed as Chaplain
	shall be an ordained clergyman in good standing in the religious
	body from which he/she is selected.

Section 2:	The Township Manager may appoint up to four (4) Chaplains in
	the unclassified service.

Section 3:	Chaplains shall serve without rank or salary, however they may be
v	reimbursed for official expense as budgeted and approved by the
	Township Manager and Chief of Police.

- Section 4: Chaplains may be provided a uniform at the discretion of the Chief of Police and as budgeted by the Township Manager.
- Section 5: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after passage by the Township Council.
