

**ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF DEPTFORD ESTABLISHING A GREEN TEAM PURSUANT TO SUSTAINABLE NEW JERSEY**

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and the Township Council of the Township of Deptford strives to save tax dollars, assure clean air and water, improve working and living environments, and build a community that is sustainable economically, environmentally, and socially; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and the Township Council of the Township of Deptford wishes to build a model of government which benefits its residents with green community initiatives which are environmentally and economically sound, easy to replicate, and affordable to implement; and

**WHEREAS**, in an attempt to focus on green issues, the Township Council of the Township of Deptford wishes to establish a Green Team;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and the Township Council of the Township of Deptford as follows:

**SECTION 1. Establishment**

A group of citizens decided to the sustainability of the community and known as the Green Team, appointed by the Mayor and the Township Council is hereby established.

**SECTION 2. Purpose**

- a. To facilitate the successful completion of the requirements for certification of Sustainable Jersey;
- b. To educate and encourage all Township employees, residents, and businesses to participate in green initiatives;
- c. To collaborate with public and private green communities to ensure the replication of best practices and to ensure a coordinated effort within the Township of Deptford and with neighboring communities.

**SECTION 3. Membership**

- a. The Green Team with consist of no less than 7 nor more than 11 members and will include 2 members of the Environmental Commission, 2 Township Council members, 2 representatives from Public Works, and 1 representative from the Township Manager's Office.
- b. The Green Team shall be persons who reside or are employed in the Township of Deptford and are to be appointed to terms of 3 years.


**SECTION 4.** If any sentence, section, clause, or other portion of this ordinance, or the application thereof the any person or circumstance, shall for any reason be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair, or repeal the remainder of this ordinance.

**SECTION 5.** All ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.


**SECTION 6.** This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication required by law.


