

**ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF DEPTFORD AMENDING §7-10 OF THE
DEPTFORD MUNICIPAL CODE
TO RESTRICT PARKING ON NORMANDY AVENUE**

WHEREAS, the Township of Deptford has consulted with Office of Emergency Management officials and law enforcement officials regarding the parking of motor vehicles on Normandy Avenue having limited access to properties concerning emergency services, waste collection services, and United States Postal Services.

WHEREAS, the Township of Deptford wishes to limit the parking of motor vehicles on Normandy Avenue to ensure that continued access to properties concerning emergency services, waste collection services, and United States Postal Services are not impeded.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Township Council of the Township of Deptford, in the County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Deptford Township Municipal Code § 7-10 shall be amended by the addition of the following language to Municipal Code §7-10:

No person shall stop or stand a vehicle between the hours specified on any day upon any of the streets or parts of streets described:

Name of Street	Zone	Sides	Hours	Location
Normandy Avenue	3	North	All	Beginning at the dead end of Normandy Avenue for a distance of 200 feet

Section 2. Deptford Township Municipal Code § 7-10 shall be amended by the addition of the following language to Municipal Code §7-10:

No person shall stop or stand a vehicle, except private, non-commercial passenger cars and SUVs, between the hours specified on any upon any of the streets or parts of streets described:

Name of Street	Zone	Sides	Hours	Location
Normandy Avenue	3	South	All	Beginning at the dead end of Normandy Avenue for a distance of 200 feet

For the purposes of this section, private, non-commercial passenger car or SUV shall not include any self-propelled or towed vehicle equipped to serve as temporary living quarters for recreational, camping or travel purposes and shall also not include, motor homes, motorcycles, boats, jet skis, ATCs and ATVs.

Section 3. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent or in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to said inconsistencies and conflict.

Section 4. Severability. If any section, part of any section, or clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the remaining provisions of this ordinance. The governing body of the Township of Deptford declares that it would have passed the ordinance and each section and subsection thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more of the subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases may be declared unconstitutional or invalid.


