ORDINANCE NO. 3 OF 2024

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A SCHEDULE OF FEES AND PAY RATES FOR CITY-ORDERED FIRE WATCH.

WHEREAS an ordinance is necessary to establish a schedule of fees and pay rates for a city-ordered Fire Watch.

WHEREAS the benefit of this temporary measure intends to ensure continuous and systematic surveillance of a building or portion thereof, by one or more qualified individuals, for the purpose of controlling fire and maintaining safety line.

WHEREAS the Fire Official or their designee orders a Fire Watch under the following circumstances: A. Required fire protection systems are impaired or out of service; B. A Fire Watch is requested by the building owner, tenant, or leasing party; C. Public or private events where 100 people or more are in attendance; D. The presence of an imminent hazard as defined by N.J.A.C. 5:70-2.16; E. Conducting hot work; and F. All other situations deemed necessary by the Fire Official or their assigned designee.

WHEREAS Fire Watches shall be performed by the employees of the City of East Orange Fire Prevention Bureau and qualified members of the East Orange Fire Department. Other qualified individuals may be utilized at the discretion of the Fire Official or their assigned designee.

WHEREAS the Fire Official or their designee shall stipulate the terms of the Fire Watch to include staffing, equipment needs, and back-up fire protection based on each situation. Responsibilities include: A. Notifying the Fire Department and building occupants to an emergency; B. Assisting evacuations; C. Surveillance of the property; D. Prevention of fires; E. Extinguishment of fires; and F. Mitigation of hazards to life and property.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EAST ORANGE, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE:

A. A city-ordered Fire Watch requires payment of these fees and rates made payable to East Orange Fire Prevention withing 10 days after the service is provided.

SECTION TWO: Severability of Ordinance Provisions

SECTION FOUR: That this ordinance shall take effect upon final passage upon expiration of twenty (20) days following publication unless otherwise provided.
