ORDINANCE NO. 8 OF 2024

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING ARTICLE II CHAPTER 260-9 OF THE CITY CODE ENTITLED "STOP INTERSECTIONS" TO PROVIDE FOR THE CREATION OF A STOP SIGN AT CENTERWAY AND CRESCENT PLACE

WHEREAS, it has been determined that it would be in the best interest of the City of East Orange to amend and supplement the Municipal Code relating to "Stop Intersections" to create an additional stop sign at the following location.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of East Orange that Chapter 260-9 of the Municipal Code is supplemented as follows:

Section 1. (Additions only)

§ 260-9 of the Code is supplemented as follows:

Stop Sign On	Direction of Travel	At Intersection of
Centerway	South	Crescent Pl.

Section 2: Severability of Ordinance Provisions

Each section of this Chapter is an independent section, and the holding of any section or part thereof to be unconstitutional, void, or ineffective for any cause shall not be deemed to affect the validity or constitutionality of any other sections or parts thereof.

Section 3 : Conflict of Other Ordinance Provisions

That all ordinances and parts of ordinances and conflicts or are inconsistent with this Chapter are hereby repealed but only to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency.

Section 4 : Effective Date of Ordinance Provisions

This Chapter shall take effect upon final passage upon expiration of twenty (20) days following publication unless otherwise provided by resolution of City Council.


