A Local Law to Amend the Code of the Town/Village of East Rochester Chapter 176-31 Schedule VI entitled "Stop Intersections" by designating the following described intersection as a stop intersection.

<u>Stop Sign on</u>	<u>Direction of Travel</u>	<u>At Intersection of</u>
Roosevelt Road	Both	West Avenue and Harleston Road

Repeal. All ordinances, resolutions, local laws and parts thereof inconsistent with this Local Law are hereby repealed.

Conflicts of Law. Whenever any local law, ordinance or regulation of the Town/Village of East Rochester, County of Monroe, State of New York or United States of America is inconsistent with this Local Law whichever local law, ordinance, or regulation is more stringent shall supersede the less stringent local law, ordinance, or regulation.

Separability. If any part or provision of this Local Law or the application thereof to any person or circumstance be adjudged invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall be confined in its operation to the part or provision or application directly involved in the controversy in which judgment shall have been rendered and shall not affect or impair the validity of the remainder of this Local Law or the application thereof to other person or circumstances, and the Village Board of the Town/Village of East Rochester hereby declares that it would have passed this Local Law or the remainder thereof had such invalid application or invalid provision been apparent.

Effective Date. This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the office of the New York State Secretary of State in accordance with Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON LOCAL LAW

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that there has been presented to the Village Board of the Town/Village of East Rochester, Monroe County, New York, on October 13, 2022, a local law entitled "A Local Law to Amend the Code of the Town/Village of East Rochester Chapter 176-31, Schedule VI, entitled "Stop Intersections" Re: Roosevelt Road and the intersections of West Avenue and Harleston Road."


Said Local Law is intended to designate the intersections of Roosevelt Road and West Avenue and Roosevelt Road and Harleston Road as Stop Intersections within the Town/Village of East Rochester and to authorize the installation of signage evidencing the foregoing.

A copy of the proposed Local Law is on file with the Town/Village Clerk.

THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Town/Village of East Rochester will hold a public hearing on the local law at 317 Main Street, East Rochester, New York on November 10, 2022, at 7:00 p.m., at which time all persons interested will be heard.
