# A LOCAL LAW AMENDING CHAPTER 67, SECTION 1 OF THE CODE OF THE INCORPORATED VILLAGE OF EAST HILLS AS IT RELATES TO THE PROHIBITION OF KEEPING CERTAIN ANIMALS.

The Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Village of East Hills enacts into local law the following amendment to § 67-1:

#### Section 1: Content

Section 67-1 "Keeping of certain animals prohibited" is repealed, and in its place is enacted the following provision:

§ 67-1 Keeping of certain animals prohibited.

The keeping or harboring of any chicken, rooster or guinea fowl or the keeping, harboring, maintaining, or breeding of any bees, wild or undomesticated animals, pigs, swine, or reptiles is prohibited and is hereby declared to be a nuisance.

#### Section 2: Separability

If any section or provision of this local law shall be adjudged to be invalid or ineffective by any Court or competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate any other part of this local law or its remainder, and shall be confined in its operation to the section or provision or part of this local law which is directly involved in the controversy in which a judgment was rendered.

#### **Section 3: Effective Date**

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the New York Secretary of State.
