

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF EAST GREENWICH, CHAPTER 15 THEREOF, ENTITLED “ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES” TO AMEND SECTION 15-10, ENTITLED “CAP ON TOTAL LIQUOR LICENSES IN THE TOWN OF EAST GREENWICH” TO INCREASE THE CAP FOR CLASS B-V FROM 37 TO 38.

Section 1. The Town Council of the Town of East Greenwich hereby ordains:

Chapter 15, entitled Alcoholic Beverages is amended as follows:

Section 15-10. Cap on total liquor licenses in the Town of East Greenwich.

The maximum number of liquor license that shall be issued by the East Greenwich Town Council, sitting as the Board of License Commissioners, in each respective class, shall be as follows:

- Class A – three (3) licenses;
- Class B-T – one (1) license;
- Class B-V – thirty-~~seven-eight~~ (38) licenses;
- Class B-V limited (BVL) – seven (7) licenses, one of which shall only be issued to individuals and not to corporations or other legal entities and shall be issued on the express condition that the license shall not be transferred and shall revert to the Town if not renewed by the holder.
- Class C – two (2) licenses;
- Class D – four (4) licenses.

As of the date of this ordinance, the Town Council, sitting as the Board of License Commissioners, shall not issue any new liquor licenses that would cause the number of licenses issued to exceed the limits set forth herein. If, as of the date this ordinance is enacted, the number of licenses currently issued by the Town shall already be in excess of the maximum number set forth herein, the Council may continue to renew such licenses, but shall not reissue such license if the license holder shall allow the license to expire.

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.
